

London Marathon 2026 - Participant Terms and Conditions

1. By applying for a Golden Bond place with Cancer Research Wales, you agree to the terms and conditions set by the race organiser, London Marathon Events.
2. Your application will be subject to a selection process so that Cancer Research Wales can ensure that the places are used to best-possible effect.
3. You must be 18 years old on the date of the 2026 TCS London Marathon to enter the race and to apply for a place.
4. If successful, you agree to pay a £25 registration fee to Cancer Research Wales to secure your place no later than 14 days after it has been confirmed by Cancer Research Wales. This registration fee will be in addition to the minimum sponsorship agreement of £2,250.
5. By applying for one of our guaranteed places in the 2026 TCS London Marathon, you are pledging to raise the minimum sponsorship of £2,250 and will endeavour to personally cover any shortfall. Monies reclaimed by Cancer Research Wales from the Inland Revenue for Gift Aid, does not count towards the total value of the sponsorship you raise.
6. 80% of your fundraising target (£1,800) must be raised by 14th February 2025. The remaining 20% (£450) or more can be collected up to 4 weeks after the race, by 31st May 2026.
7. If you decide you no longer want to participate in the 2026 TCS London Marathon, you must inform Cancer Research Wales before 31st December 2025 where you will forfeit your £25 registration fee. Should you withdraw, all sponsorship forms and monies collected

should be forwarded to Cancer Research Wales or returned to your - sponsors. Most of our supporters find that their sponsors are usually only too happy for sponsorship already given to be donated to the charity if there is a valid reason for withdrawal.

8. If you sustain an injury, please contact Cancer Research Wales in writing at the earliest opportunity. It is important that you do not take part in the marathon unless you are fit to do so. You will however forfeit your £25 registration fee. In relation to sponsorship, we would be grateful if you could talk to your sponsors about the money you have raised. Most of our supporters find that their sponsors are usually only too happy for sponsorship already given to be donated to the charity if there is a valid reason for withdrawal.
9. All place holders agree that images taken on the day of the marathon may be used by Cancer Research Wales in future promotional material, unless stated otherwise.
